**Exodus 20:18,19,21** Now when all the people saw the thunder and the flashes of lightning and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking, the people were afraid and trembled, and they stood far off 19 and said to Moses, "You speak to us, and we will listen; but do not let God speak to us, lest we die... The people stood far off, while Moses drew near to the thick darkness where God was.

**Exodus 24:3** Moses came and told the people all the words of the Lord and all the rules. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words that the Lord has spoken we will do."

**Exodus 34:27** And the Lord said to Moses, "Write these words, for in accordance with these words I have made a <u>covenant</u> with you and with Israel."

**Hebrews 8:6** But as it is, Christ has obtained a ministry that is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises.

**Hebrews 9:15** Therefore he is the <u>mediator of a new covenant</u>, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant.
