










GENESIS 1:1

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.



Earth formed from debris orbiting around our sun about 4.5 billion years ago. The story begins earlier with the Big Bang nearly 14 billion years ago, which spewed hydrogen atoms throughout the universe.

Creation: The Creation of the universe came about just as the Word of God described; it was a six-day Creation event. The true age of the earth (and all of the physical universe) is measured in thousands (not billions) of years (Genesis 1-11). Mankind began with two individuals who came into being through a special, personal, creative act of God (Genesis 2).

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Flood: There was a time when the entire world was covered with water as the result of a year-long Flood. This was a judgment from God on all human and land dwelling life. It resulted in the death of all humans (and animals) who were not in the Ark during the Flood (Genesis 6-9).



God made a perfect world, but man's rebellion brought death, suffering, and disease into this world.



Ethics is produced by evolution, but not justified by it, because, like Macbeth's dagger, it serves a powerful purpose without existing in substance."







Did Adam have a belly button?






JONAH 1:15-17



MATTHEW 12:38-41

Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered [Jesus], saying, "Teacher, we wish to see a sign from you."
